The M-DISC is the first ever permanent file backup disc that lasts forever.

Most writable DVDs, including the most expensive "Gold" archival DVDs, burn data into an organic dye layer. Organic dyes start to degrade and fade as soon as they are written. This leads to a condition called "data rot".

This problem is so severe that the U.S. National Archives warns that **the shelf life of a regular DVD is 2-5 years.**



Unlike computer hard-drives and optical discs (CD and DVD) that suffer from decay, destroying the files you were trying to preserve and protect, the M-DISC cannot be overwritten, erased, or corrupted by natural processes.


